SPRING YARD WASTE COLLECTION BEGINS APRIL 3, 2023

For those residents with **GREEN** recycling lids, yard waste will be collected every other week on your recycling day starting the week of **April 3, 2023**.

For those residents with **BLUE** recycling lids, yard waste will be collected every other week on your recycling day starting the week of **April 10, 2023**.

Remember yard waste must be placed curbside in 32-gallon trash containers, marked with two Yard Waste stickers provided by the town or be placed in 30-gallon brown paper biodegradable bags, which may be purchased locally. Containers may not exceed 50 pounds in weight.

INCLUDE: leaves, twigs (1" or less), grass clippings, weeds and flowers, wood chips, house and garden plants, hedge and shrub prunings and other easily raked yard waste.

DO NOT INCLUDE: food scraps, brush, trash of any kind, soil, sod, rocks or tree limbs or branches greater than 1" in diameter. The larger branches will be picked up on your regular trash collection day to be incinerated IF cut in sections no longer than three feet and tied in a bundle with string no larger than two feet in diameter; however, no one piece can be more than 6" in diameter.
