Minutes

March 20th Minutes were approved by all attendees excepting Claus Becker who was absent from that meeting and who abstained.

Chenery Heaters

Committee discussed alternatives for heating of Chenery. Kevin Bleau presented a rough analysis showing if the school roof were fully covered with solar panels, 14% of annual electric boiler electricity consumption could be covered if the town went for 100% electric boilers. An estimated 28% if a solution of 50% electric and 50% gas boilers were chosen. Demand charges for the school may make the 100% electric boiler solution financially unattractive.

Incinerator Site

Kopperl met w Sam Osmancevic from Belmont Light (BL) to discuss next steps.

Beals Associates Inc., a site developer, is working w BL to develop the site plan. MA legislative waiver would be required to use the site for non-municipal use. Then RFP. Belmont needs to decide what activities they would support having on the site. Currently, energy storage and solar are the only permitted uses.

Climate leader application for Belmont

The committee to submit two documents to Selectboard. One on climate leader application and one on the permitted legal uses for incinerator site.
