- Merge Recreation, Senior Center and Veterans (ID 78) Scored as .30
- Establish a working group of town administrators/managers with comparable communities (ID 108) - Scored as .53
- Unify police and fire as public safety force (ID 222) Scored as .43
- Outsource emergency response services (ID 223) Scored as .14
- Reduce the number of documents/reports created by the Town (ID 334) Scored as .07
- Improve the efficacy and efficiency of capital projects and expenditures (ID 344) -Scored as .37
- Lobby legislature for the PILOT program to be mandatory (ID 352) Scored as .40

- Regionalize town services, including trash pickup (ID 330) Because of service implications of a potential shift to five-day trash pickup, the working group needs to discuss this idea with the Revenue, Budget, and Services working group.
