

## History of Harvard Lawn Actions

### 2009 Harvard Lawn Access Restrictions

**January 8, 2009**

Neighborhood residents concerned with cut through traffic. Previous efforts, in 2004, to implement turn and access restrictions to prevent commuter cut through traffic were unsuccessful because the neighborhood was also subject to the restrictions.

**February 12, 2009**

New turn and access restrictions were proposed.

A public meet was scheduled for April 9, 2009

**April 9, 2009**

TAC approves the following recommendations:

Unity Avenue at Grove Street	Left Turn Only – 4pm to 6 pm
Fairview Avenue at Grove Street	Left Turn Only – 4pm to 6pm
Grove Street at Unity Avenue	No Left Turn – 7am to 9am

Sent to the Select Board for approval.

**May 18, 2009**

Select Board approves TAC recommendations.

Restrictions remain in place today.

### 2014 Harvard Lawn Traffic Issues

**May 12, 2014**

Email concern received from representative of the Belmont Corner Neighborhood Association (BCNA) comprised of the neighborhood bounded by Grove Street, Fairview Avenue, Oxford Avenue, and Belmont Street.

Issues include:

- Vehicles driving through the neighborhood to avoid the traffic signals at Belmont Street and Grove Street
- Pothole complaints
- Vehicles accessing Marion Road against the One Way direction
- Request for crosswalk improvements on Grove Street at the playground

All issues were discussed and responded to without formal TAC involvement.

**2014 Marlboro Street at Unity Avenue Intersection**

**November 13, 2014**

Marlboro Street at Unity Avenue – Request for a Four-Way Stop Approach. Was not deemed a candidate for all way stop.

**2015 Exeter Street Parking Restrictions**

Complaint regarding parked cars too close to driveways.

No Parking signs installed on west side of Exeter Street.

NOTE: No Parking signs are in place on west side of Oxford Avenue, but not on Marlboro Street.

**2020 Oxford Avenue Parking Restriction**

**November 5, 2020**

Request from owner of Lord’s Cleaners, Belmont Street, for a parking restriction on Oxford Avenue at the Corner of Belmont Street.

One Hour parking restriction installed at first two parking spaces on Oxford Avenue.

**February 8, 2021**

Select Board approves TAC recommendations.
